



Login Instructions for Extension Foundation

1. Go to [Extension Foundation Online Campus](https://campus.extension.org/) (<https://campus.extension.org/>)
2. Click on Login




3. If you already have an account, you can login by entering your username/password or logging in with your Google account. Follow the steps on the left. If you don't have an account, click "Create new account" on the right side of the page.



The next few screenshots will walk you through setting up a new account.

- You will see a “cookie policy” to agree to. And no, they aren’t talking about chocolate chip cookies, but rather tracking data which helps the system keep track of where you are in the class. When you log back in later, you are able to pick up where you left off.



- Then comes the form where you type in a username and password, plus some more identifiers for your account. Anything with a “!” is required to fill out. Note: If you can use a personal email address, as some of our high schools are blocking outside email messages. The Extension System will automatically send you an email to confirm you are a real person, not a bot...so you need to be able to get that email.

Note: This site is used by people from all different countries. The question about “County” is where you live or where your school is, but feel free to type “NA” if you would rather not disclose it, or the zip code.




6. After clicking “create my new account,” you should see this screen pictured below. Go check your email for the message that was sent.


7. In your email inbox, you should see an email from **eXtension Campus Help Desk (via Campus)** noreply@campus.extension.org. Once you open that email, you see the message pictured below. Click on (or copy and paste) the browser address provided in the email (this address is specific to your account, so be sure to use the one provided to you in YOUR email).



8. Once you have followed the link address sent to you in your email from extension, you should then be routed to your account registration confirmation, which should look like this screen pictured below. Select "Continue."



9. After you select "Continue" you should then see this page (pictured below) that will offer you a tour of the site so you can get more familiar with this platform. **We strongly encourage that you select "Next" here and take the short tour of the site.** Alternatively, you can select "End Tour" if you are familiar with this platform, and you will bypass the site tour.



10. Once you have finished your site tour, follow this link to take you straight to the Crop Wild Relatives course: <https://campus.extension.org/course/view.php?id=2253>.

On this page, you see enrollment options. Find the name GRIN-U and enter your enrollment key: GRINU Then, select “Enroll me.”
